I wish to thank you and the group for their support, over the past couple of weeks.

Having considered the political situation in IACC and last Fridays meeting of creating joint leadership of Plaid Cymru and labour, I find that completely unbelievable for such a small island like Anglesey.

Up to 6 months ago I was acceptable to Mr Davis Bowles to be within the tent, it is a fact I did sign the draft terms of engagement for political alliance, within 10 minutes further papers were presented to us in the meeting of naming and shaming councillors, I could not concur with this system of working and was shocked for some of the petty and childish reasons, I have been named by Mr David Bowles that I have a strong personality and a political operator. It seems that I am being penalised for standing on my own two feet challenging what I strongly believe to be totally wrong. As the minister stated in the assembly that personality issues should not be the priority as people should work together, that naming is not only misguided but also no recipe for the sustainable recovery.
