Such steps to include undertaking land searches and referencing of all interests and rights which may required to deliver construction and improvement (including works issuing requisitions for information under the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 and/or under the Highways Act 1980), preparing draft Orders and documentation related undertaking all steps required to allow such Orders to be made and should such subsequently be authorised by the Executive. Following the completion of the Agreement above, to enter into negotiations with those persons with an interest in land or rights needed to deliver the construction and improvement works in order to acquire, where possible, such land and rights by agreement, to include making offers to acquire such land and riahts and entering into agreements to acquire such land and rights as the Head of Service (Highways, Waste and Property) considers appropriate.
