2 - Constituency Activity

I have assisted the electorate on a number of matters relating to the services offered by the Council. Specifically over the last year -

- I have called planning applications into the Planning Committee when detailed challenge is needed and have spoken in favour or against applications as needed.
- I have assisted with the interpretation of the housing legislation in relation to the premium on second homes, especially when the building has been purposely built as a holiday dwelling.
- I have assisted individuals who are homeless and who need a house.
- I have followed up on requests for maintenance work on houses.
- I have noted and followed up on deficiencies to the highway and on public footpaths.
- I have volunteered to collect shopping and deliver prescriptions to residents during the recent Covid-19 pandemic.
- I am the Chair of Moelfre Lifeboat and have been chairing the monthly risk management meeting.

3 - Initiatives and Special Activities

Because of the cuts to County Council budgets the Council has been trying to transfer assets such as Public Conveniences to Community Councils. Llanfairmathafarneithaf Community Council has taken responsibility for facilities on the Square and on the beach. As part of this work, we have been cleaning the facilities and have prepared a specification of work in order to form a tender to upgrade them.

Something else that included a lot of arranging was the amalgamation of Ysgol Goronwy Owen School and Ysgol Moelfre School. These schools are now working as one school and have one Head Teacher and one Governing Body.
