I am a town councillor in Menai Bridge and regularly attend Council Meetings and the Finance and Planning Committee. I also occasionally attend the Community Council Meetings at Llanfairpwll and Penmynydd.

During the year I have actively been working on getting UK Highways to carry out repairs to the lighting on the Menai Suspension Bridge and some progress had been made in this respect prior to the outbreak of COVID-19.

I have also held regular meeting during the year with various stakeholders regarding the old chapel site at Wood Street, Menai Bridge.

I continue to work closely with the Highways department at Ynys Mon to ensure the planning and delivery of the proposed flood alleviation schemes for Menai Bridge and Llanfairpwll following the devastating floods of November 2017.

I have dealt with numerous issues on behalf of local residents of the ward relating to housing, planning, anti-social behaviour, highways and environmental issues.
