2 - Constituency Activity

I continue to have the honour of representing the residents of Aethwy Ward along with my colleagues.

In addition to serving on the committees above I also attend a number of other meetings throughout the ward. I am a town councillor in Menai Bridge and regularly attend Council Meetings and the Finance and Planning Committee. I also occasionally attend the Community Council Meetings at Llanfairpwll and Penmynydd.

During the year I continued to fight against the proposal to site a Temporary Gypsy and Travellers site alongside the A5 in Star and also continued supporting the flood victims from November 2017 both in Menai Bridge and Llanfairpwll. I have dealt with numerous issues on behalf of local residents of the ward relating to housing, planning, anti-social behaviour, highways and environmental issues.

3 - Initiatives and Special Activities

I have seen a significant increase in my responsibilities during the year having been appointed Finance Portfolio Holder at the County Council's meeting in May 2018.

During the autumn of 2018 I completed the Local Government Pension Scheme Fundamentals Training Programme following my appointment to the Gwynedd Pensions Fund Committee.
