Gwynedd and Anglesey Adoption Panel	I am the sole County Councillor representative for Gwynedd and Môn on this Panel. The Panel carries out the important work of matching children ready for adoption with prospective adopters and meets on a monthly basis to consider individual cases.
North Wales Community Health Council (Ynys Môn Local Committee)	I am one of the three Ynys Môn County Councillors that sit on the North Wales Community Health Council (CHC) which is an independent statutory organisation which

represents the interests of patients and the public in the NHS in North Wales. The organisation regularly conducts surveys to gain information about patients experiences of using the NHS so that concerns can be raised and improvements made. North Wales Fire & Rescue Authority I am one of the three Ynys Môn County Councillors that have been appointed to serve on the North Wales Fire and Rescue Authority (NWFRA) which monitors the performance and budget of the North Wales Fire and Rescue Service. I also sit on the Executive Sub-Committee. In this year's Annual Meeting May I again had the privilege of being re-elected as Deputy Chair of the Authority. As a result I meet regularly with the Chair and Chief Officer to discuss strategic and operational issues. North Wales Police & Crime Panel I am the sole Ynys Môn Councillor representative appointed to serve on the North Wales Police and Crime Panel (NWPCP). The role of this Panel is to monitor the performance and budget of the North Wales Police & Crime Commissioner. School Governor - Ysgol Gymuned Bodffordd I am the Deputy Chair of the Board of Governors for Ysgol Gymuned Bodffordd. I am Vice-Chair of the Board of School Governor - Canolfan Addysg y Bont Governors for Canolfan Addysg y Bont which is a school in Llangefni providing learning for pupils who have a statement of special educational needs. Pupils have

a wide range of learning
needs, including severe
learning difficulties, profound
and multiple learning
difficulties and autistic
spectrum disorders.

2 - Ward Activity

In addition to sitting on the above committees I also regularly attend a number of other meetings throughout my ward including:

Town and Community Council Meetings - I regularly attend the monthly meetings of Llangefni Town Council so that I can support the work of the Town Council in my role as a County Councillor. I have also assumed the lead responsibility amongst the three Canolbarth Môn Councillors for supporting Llanddyfnan Community Council and I regularly attend their monthly meetings.

Llangefni Social Enterprise – This Social Enterprise is responsible for the Llangefni Urban Sports Park and I am Chair of the project group. The Park continues to be enormously successful with 80-100 users visiting the Park on a daily basis to ride their scooters, skateboard and use the outdoor gym and basketball court

Gobaith Môn – This is a Christian Charity that I support on a personal basis and I am Secretary for the trustees. The organisation works exclusively with young people in schools, churches and communities across the island seeking to provide for their well-being and helping them to reach their full potential.

Red Squirrels Wales Trust – I am a member of this organisation which has done amazing work in re-introducing suitable habitats to conserve the native species of red squirrels e.g. Nant y Pandy, Llangefni.

Llangefni Partnership – I am a member of this local Regeneration Group chaired by leuan Wyn Jones which brings individuals and organisations together with the aim of revitalising Llangefni.

3 - Initiatives and Special Activities

I continue to serve my local community by regularly volunteering to assist the following organisations:

Bwyd da Mon (<u>www.bwyd-da-mon.org.uk</u>) – serving in the Llangefni store.

Llangefni Parkrun - carrying out Marshall duties.

Llangefni Town FC - assisting with stewarding on big match days.
