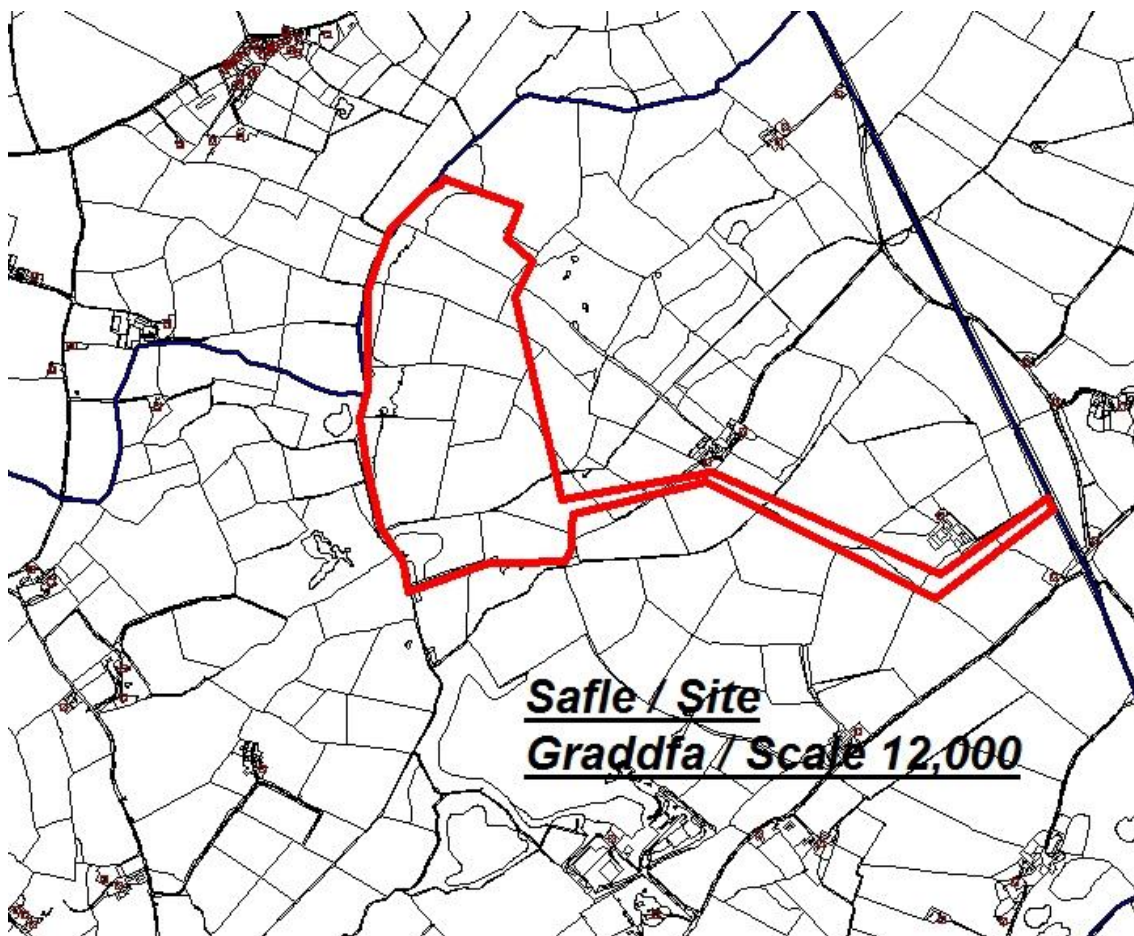

**Report of Head of Planning Service (NJ)**

**Recommendation:**

Defer

**Reason for Reporting to Committee:**

The application is a full application for the erection of three 800kW - 900kW wind turbines with a maximum hub height of up to 55m, rotor diameter of up to 52m and a maximum upright vertical tip height of up to 81m, the improvements to the existing access to the A5025 road together with the erection of 3 equipment housing cabinets on land at Bryn Eryr Uchaf, Porthaethwy.

At its meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> December 2013 the Planning and Orders Committee resolved to visit the site before making its determination. The site was visited in 20<sup>th</sup> December.

At its meeting held on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2014 the Planning and Orders Committee resolved to defer determination of the application in order to receive outstanding consultee responses and to receive additional information from the applicant and to allow their consideration. These remain outstanding.

At its meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> February, the Committee resolved to again defer consideration of the application as consultee replies remained outstanding and further information was awaited from the applicant. An objection to the application has now been received from Natural Resources Wales with details forwarded to the applicant. At the time of writing the applicant has issued a response to NRW which is currently under consideration. Details of mitigation measures are awaited from the applicant in relation to radio links.
