The minutes of the special meeting held on 28 February, 2017 were confirmed.

#### **3** REPORTS OF SUB-COMMITTEES OF THE CHARITABLE TRUST

#### **Regeneration Committee**

The minutes of the meeting held on 24 February, 2017 were confirmed and adopted as necessary.

The Treasurer said that the recommendation of the Regeneration Committee to support 12 grant applications required confirmation by the full Trust but the information remained confidential until the final decision of the Trust.

It was RESOLVED to exclude the press and public and to adopt the following:-

The Treasurer reported that a total of 31 applications were received which totalled to over £1.6m. The Regeneration Committee was convened on 10 February, 2017 and 24 February, 2017 to discuss those applications.

The Chair said that he was concerned that there will be only be 2 Independent Trustees on the established Isle of Anglesey Charitable Association. He noted that he was of the opinion that the Charitable Association should look into increasing the number of independent trustees in the future.

# APPOINTING OFFICERS AND MEMBERS TO THE TRUST'S COMMITTEES

1 Isle of Anglesey County Council is the Trustee of the Isle of Anglesey Charitable Trust, operating through its members. When acting as trustees they do so completely separately of the Council.

Following the Council Elections in May 2017 members need to be appointed to act as officers for the Trust and the committee structure needs to be determined and members appointed to serve on those committees. These are matters to be resolved upon jointly by all members of the Trust.

- 2 Historically, the Trust has operated with a Chair and Vice-Chair along with three committees, namely
  - Investments and Contracts Committee;
  - General Grants Committee;
  - Regeneration Committee.
- 3 Another matter requiring attention is the question of political balance on the committees. In this context, the members have tried to avoid introducing political aspects in the Trust's activities and it was expected that each member serves on one of the three committees.
- 4 In view of the above and given that the Trust has made an application to change the governance structure to a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO), it is recommended in the short term to continue with the current arrangements and take the opportunity to review the committee structure when the Charity Commission's final decision is known.

# 5 **Recommendations**

Appoint a Chair and Vice-Chair and confirm their role in authorising expenditure.

Appoint members to serve on the following committees

- Investments and Contracts Committee;
- General Grants Committee;
- Regeneration Committee.
