Y budd i'r cyhoedd wrth beidio â datgelu yw osgoi'r tebygolrwydd o enwi unigolion neu ddatgelu gwybodaeth am unigolion mewn ffordd sydd yn mynd yn groes i ddarpariaethau peidio â datgelu Deddf Diogelu Data'r DU 2018.  Hefyd, mae'n amlwg bod budd i'r cyhoedd wrth beidio â datgelu gwybodaeth sydd yn ymwneud â materion ariannol neu fusnes unigolion, yn enwedig dan yr amgylchiadau hynny lle mae dyletswydd hyder yn ddyledus neu'n ddisgwylledig.  The public interest in not disclosing is served by averting the likelihood that disclosure would result in the identification of individuals or result in the disclosure about individuals in a way that would breach the non-disclosure provisions of the UK Data Protection Act 2018.  Also, it is evident that there exists a strong public interest in not disclosing information that relates to the financial or business affairs of individuals, particularly in circumstances where a duty of confidence is owed or expected.
