DECISION	<p>Menai Suspension Bridge</p> <p>The Motion as amended was carried as follows :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Annibynwyr Môn Group call on Anglesey County Council to take all measures possible to apply pressure on Welsh Government to re-open the Menai Suspension Bridge as a matter of urgency. • This closure took effect without prior consultation or notification with the County Council. • The Council is seriously concerned about the lack of resilience of the two current crossing over the Menai Straits which has once again been highlighted following the recent complete closure of the Menai Suspension Bridge which has left one crossing only. • The Council is disappointed in Welsh Government in relation to their lack of holding contractors to account and their unwillingness to

	<p>consider the links between Anglesey and the mainland and the effects on the residents and communities of the Island.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welsh Government be asked to step in to offer support to businesses of the town of Menai Bridge, who have suffered a great deal as a result of the problems with the Bridge over the last 3 years. The hospitality businesses especially have suffered following the overnight closure of the bridge.
