I am a member and Vice-chairman of Cwm Cadnant Community Council which I attend monthly. I am in constant contact with the clerk of the council to discuss and resolver any matters arising within the local community. I, also, attend Beaumaris Town Council, and both Llanddona Community Council and Llangoed Community Council regularly as often as possible. I prepare and report back to these councils as often as possible and act on their behalf when the needs arise. Of late, I have attended meetings of Beaumaris's Chamber of Trade.

I am glad to have been able to give support and advice to my constituents. I am available via email or the phone. I have given assistance to the electorate and their families in many different ways e.g.:

- Planning have responded to requests to speak with the Planning department, to oppose or find more information
- Highways Enquiries regarding a number of issues regarding roads, parking, etc.. within the ward
- Environment Dealing with complaints regarding waste not collected or waste left on sides of roads
- Housing Contacting the department on the behalf of tenants of the council when the needs arise

As of last year, a great deal of my time at the beginning of this year has been spent on meeting constituents and taking part in public meetings, etc in support of the primary schools in Beaumaris, Llandegfan and Llangoed due to the proposed reorganization and/or modernization of schools in the Seiriol ward as well as the recent consultation on lowering the school age for full attendance of Ysgol Llandegfan.

As a Member and vice-chairman of the Scrutiny panel I have had the privilege of meeting many Anglesey school Heads and Chairs of the Governors.
